

PROTECT YOUR DAUGHTER FROM CERVICAL CANCER

Cervical cancer is the 2nd most common cancer in women aged up to 35. Around 3000 women are diagnosed every year in the UK alone.

Infection by human papilloma virus (HPV) has been shown to be the major cause and this can be passed from partner to partner.

A revolutionary new vaccine called Gardasil has so far been found to protect non-infected women from **70%** of cervical cancer types and **90%** of other HPV related conditions.

Guidelines are currently focussed on administering the vaccine to females between the ages of 9 and 26; preferably before exposure to potential HPV infection.

The vaccine is given by injection into the upper arm or thigh, and 3 doses are required. Side effects are minimal. The length of vaccine protection is not yet known, but it has already been shown to protect for at least 5 years.

Unfortunately Gardasil is not available on the NHS, but your local Private GP, DOCTORnow, can give you the whole course for £345.
